In order to ensure student's comprehension of the text, they are to answer the following questions (on a separate sheet of paper) as they read: What is this historical account mostly about? What are cotton **bolts**? How did the cotton gin contribute to the development of the cotton industry in the South? Why couldn't Southern states make money by growing cotton in 1792? Once they have answered these questions, they are to upload these responses in the TEAMS CHAT BOX on Thursday evening.

Students should also complete iReady Book (page31). There are three questions on this page. Once they have answered these questions, they are to upload these responses in the TEAMS CHAT BOX on Thursday evening.
