Hey Mathematicians!

The week of **November 30th**, we will be reviewing our lesson 11, which looks at creating equations for proportional relationships, and being able to use those equations with tables and graphs. We will also start the review process for our December testing.

During class we will be introducing variables into our knowledge of fractions and how to solve problems.

At home, we will try to further this knowledge with practice, activities and assessments. Look in the box below to see what your Hybrid students will be doing each day of the week at home.

This will review the ideas behind proportional relationships and constants of proportionality. This math is very important in understanding statistics and science experiments in the future.
