This Week, Purple and Gold students will ... review Reading Informational Texts standards: RI 6.1, 6.2, 6.3, 6.4, 6.5, and 6.6. Students will also continue Narrative Writing.

OBJECTIVES

Students will closely read, analyze, and annotate a literary text to comprehend what the author says explicitly and to discover the levels of meaning embedded deeply within literary texts, provide evidence of the central idea, theme, and summary of main points, evidence of the plot development, author's purpose for writing, and how the author develops the point of view of the narrator.

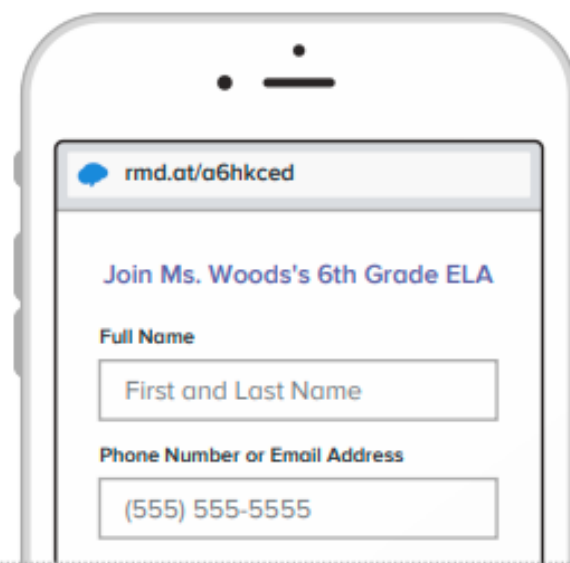
